We also provide trail rides, riding lessons, and customized one-day camps; call for details. All campers are required to bring water and lunches. Campers must wear jeans, boots, or sneakers. We strongly recommend a riding helmet. A bike helmet will suffice but is not advisable. We do have helmets to borrow. Campers should wear sun block and drink water before arriving and throughout the day. It will be hot! A change of clothes including a swimsuit and towel is needed for afternoon activities. Advanced camp is a trail camp where riders will be expected to canter.
