1. Period weapons only. No shotguns. **Artillery pieces must be full size and authentic for the period.**
2. Only officers, cavalry, and enlisted artillery may carry pistols
3. Henry repeating rifles can ONLY be used in a dismounted/skirmish line formation. No "freewheeling" or "rifleman" fighting tactics.
4. To handle black powder weapons, must be 16 years of age or older. 15 year olds allowed if accompanied by parents on the field.
5. Participants must register and sign volunteer form. It is for your benefit, if not completed you will not be allowed on the field.
6. Officers and NCO's are responsible for the conduct of their units.
7. Only period authentic uniforms and clothing permitted on the field. If you have questions regarding this requirement, please ask. We want you to enjoy yourself and have fun, while being accurate as historically possible.
- 8. Vehicles must be out of the Re-enactment Camps from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and parked in designated re-enactor parking areas.**
9. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed before battles.
10. Camp and cook fires are not to be left unattended.
11. Children and pets are not to be left unsupervised.
